Warfarin Guideline for INR Target Range of 2 - 3	6511CATC	2

To provide CAT Clinic nurse guidelines to manage patients on oral anticoagulation therapy.

1. When referral accepted the following guideline will be followed for patients that have an order for an INR TR of 2.0 -3.0.
2. Notify the referring physician when stop date is reached.
3. Notify the referring physician if a new medication is started that has a known interaction with warfarin.
4. Adjust warfarin dose as follows if patient has been on warfarin > 14 days and on same dose for > 9 days:

Current INR	Prior INR (5 days on same dose)	Continue same dose and repeat INR 4 weeks	Decrease dose by 5 - 15% and repeat INR in 9-12 days	Increase dose by 5 - 15% and repeat INR in 9-12 days.	Notify physician
≤ 1.5	Any				X
1.6 – 1.9	Any			X
